




### **OUR KINGDOM CONCEPT**

**VALUES:** Why are we doing it?




**STRATEGY:** How are we doing it?

# **VALUES**

Values are the motivational flame of the church. They are the shared convictions that guide our actions and reveal our strengths. Values answer, "Why are we doing it?" These are the things we hold in high esteem and never compromise. When you come to Victory Church, you should feel these values and see them displayed in all we do.

#### **GOD'S PRESENCE** CHANGING LIVES

**Definition:** Creating atmospheres for the Holy Spirit to be discovered and experienced resulting in changed lives.

#### **Demonstrated By:**

- · Fully engaging in vibrant worship of God
- · Fervent corporate prayer that pushes vision forward
- · The learning and demonstration of spiritual gifts
- · The work of salvation, freedom, and healing in peoples' lives

- Exodus 33:14–15 (NCV) The Lord answered, "I myself will go with you, and I will give you victory." Then Moses said to him, "If you yourself don't go with us, then don't send us away from this place."
- 2 Corinthians 3:17 (NIV) Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.
- Acts 4:31 (NIV) After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they
  were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.
- Acts 16:15-26 About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and
  the other prisoners were listening to them. Suddenly there was such a violent earthquake
  that the foundations of the prison were shaken. At once all the prison doors flew open, and
  everybody's chains came loose.




#### **GOD'S WORD DEFINING TRUTH**

**Definition:** God's standard of truth by which we live and lead.

#### **Demonstrated By:**

- Preaching and teaching God's Word in all environments
- Recognizing it's relevancy in today's ever-changing culture
- · Receiving it's challenge to change and grow
- · Not just knowing it, but experiencing it

- Job 23:12 (NIV) I have not departed from the commands of his lips; I have treasured the words of his mouth more than my daily bread.
- 2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NIV) All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- John 17:17 (NIV) Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.
- Hebrews 4:12 (NIV) For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.



#### **HONOR LIFTING PEOPLE**

**Definition:** A heart of humility that lifts others through thoughts, actions, and words.

#### **Demonstrated By:**

- Sharing the Gospel with people far from God
- Lifting people to their God-given potential
- · Showing hospitality to others
- Being generous with others through encouragement, grace, kindness, and resources
- · Open and respectful communication that seeks to understand, confront, and reconcile

#### **Scriptural Support:**

- *Philippians 2:3 (NIV)* Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves.
- 1 Peter 5:6 (NLT) So humble yourselves under the mighty power of God, and at the right time he will lift you up in honor.
- Romans 12:10 (ESV) Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.

#### **CELEBRATION EXPRESSING GRATITUDE**

**Definition:** Living lives of passionate thanksgiving to God and others.

#### **Demonstrated By:**

- Making a big deal about God
- · Applauding big and small wins in life
- Offering a sacrifice of praise in hard seasons
- Recognizing mission and vision lived out
- Expressive corporate worship

- Zephaniah 3:17 (CEV) The Lord your God wins victory after victory and is always with you. He celebrates and sings because of you, and he will refresh your life with His love.
- Philippians 4:4 (TPT) Be cheerful with joyous celebration in every season of life. Let your joy
  overflow.
- *John 12:3 (CEV)* Mary took a very expensive bottle of perfume and poured it on Jesus' feet. She wiped them with her hair, and the sweet smell of the perfume filled the house.
- 2 Samuel 6:14–15 (GW) ... David danced in the Lord's presence with all his might. He and the entire nation of Israel brought the ark of the Lord with shouts of joy and the sounding of rams' horns.



#### **GRIT** POWERING THROUGH

**Definition:** Having fortitude of mind and heart to persevere when faced with adversity.

#### **Demonstrated By:**

- Doing hard things
- Putting on God's armor to fight life's challenges
- · Coming alongside others in battle
- Persisting toward a goal despite difficulty
- · Denying self and choosing God's will at any cost

- Hebrews 12:1–3 (NIV) ...And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.
- *Philippians 3:13–15 (GW)* Brothers and sisters, I can't consider myself a winner yet. This is what I do: I don't look back, I lengthen my stride, and I run straight toward the goal to win the prize that God's heavenly call offers in Christ Jesus.
- Ephesians 6:13 (GNTD) So put on God's armor now! Then when the evil day comes, you will be
  able to resist the enemy's attacks; and after fighting to the end, you will still hold your ground.



# **STRATEGY**

**Strategy** is the process that shows how the church will accomplish the mission on the broadest level. It answers the question, "**How are we doing it?**" Strategy **shows the way** — the 'Victory Way.' It is the rhythm of our church body and shows you where to go for your continued growth. Clear strategy helps us do fewer things with better quality.

- Participating in outreach, locally and/or globally


#### I LIVE IN FREEDOM
